Feb. 4, 09 - Bostonia Woman's Club meeting. Bring in items for Art Festival & Tea Baskets.

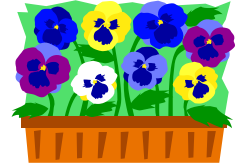
